All our African cape reed thatch tiles are treated with a specialist fungal and insect repellent chemical as standard. The naturally untreated cape thatching reed offer greater fire resistance than any other alternative thatching material. For commercial applications an optional specialist fire retardant treatment is available. Fire retardants reduce the flammability of materials by either blocking the fire physically or by initiating a chemical reaction that stops the fire. The particular fire retardant chemical used by the African Thatch Company is called Flame Stop I-DST. Flame Stop I-DST is a highly concentrated fire retardant used for `hard to penetrate` materials such as thatching, bamboo, closed cell foam and other non-porous materials. This product prevents the spread of flame by developing a self-extinguishing chemical reaction.

The African cape reed thatch tiles can be purchased separately for your own projects and are an excellent way of creating a thatched roof, but without the expense and time associated with traditional thatch. ## Application Information For The Different Types Of African Cape Reed Thatch Tiles

### Standard Thatch Tile:

The standard thatch tile is the most commonly used thatch tile and is used to cover the majority of all roof structures. The standard thatch tile is mainly used to cover all straight and curved sections on a roof structure

### Heavy Thatch Tile:

The heavy thatch tile is a more denser tile and contains 50% more reed than a standard thatch tile. It can be used in place of the standard thatch tile when a heavier look is required. The heavy thatch tile is mainly used on the second row from the top of a roof structure.

### Extra Heavy Thatch Tile:

The extra heavy thatch tile is used to provide coverage when the curvature of a roof is very acute. The extra heavy thatch tile contains 50% more reed than a heavy thatch tile and is mainly used on the very top row of a roof structure.



### Corner Thatch Tile:

The corner thatch tile contains additional thatch in the centre of the tile and is used to cover corners and hips on hexagonal, octagonal, rectangular or square roof structures.



### Top Thatch Cone:

The top thatch cone forms the cap or seal on the top of a circular, hexagonal, octagonal, rectangular or square roof structure.



### Ridge Thatch Tile:

The ridge thatch tile is used to finish the top straight ridges on an apex, rectangular or oval roof structure.



### Ridge Thatch End Cap:

The ridge thatch end cap is used to finish the ends of a straight or rectangular roof structure.
